Safe Nights of Calvert County is an interfaith consortium of churches that open their hearts and churches to the homeless. The Safe Nights program brings together citizens from all faiths and civic organizations that are dedicated to a compassionate response to the plight of the homeless in Calvert County. The Safe Nights program is dedicated to protecting the homeless from the cold by providing shelter in a clean and safe environment.

Host shelters provide a cot and three nutritious meals (breakfast, dinner and a bag lunch) in a safe environment. Transportation, to the extent possible, will be provided from Prince Frederick to the outlying areas.

HUMC hosts Safe Nights for one week during the winter months. The warm meals offer an opportunity to really connect and be the light of Christ to our homeless neighbors.
